Application

Your application documents will be reviewed by the respective host universities after the deadline of application submission is expired.

Erasmus Mundus Partnerships aim at promoting institutional cooperation and mobility activities between Europe and third-country Higher Education Institutions (HEIs).

Action 2 provides support for the establishment of cooperation partnerships and scholarships of various length for European and third-country individuals.

Scholarships

Who can apply ?

Undergraduates, Masters, Doctorates, Post-doctorates, Academic Staff divided into three Target Groups (TG):

- TG 1: Nationals from Russia or an eligible European country, registered as students / work as staff in one of the member universities of the partnership; Undergraduates must have successfully completed at least one year of studies in their home institution;
- TG 2: Nationals from Russia or an eligible European country, enrolled in (or having obtained an university degree from) an university not included in the partnership
- TG 3: Students need to be Russian nationals and part of the vulnerable target groups for social and political reasons
